If a student tells a staff member that they think they are being bullied, we will:

- **talk with the student**
- **ask the student what they want to happen**
- **work out a plan together**
- **talk to their parents**
- **talk to the other student(s) involved**
- **talk with the other student's parents**

BCS has a Bí Cineálta policy to try to stop bullying behaviour. We look at this policy every year to see what is working well or what could work better. We will ask you what you think.
