STOP BULLYING Stand Up, Speak Out

We can't help if we don't know!



We want everyone at BCS to feel safe and happy

Please tell someone if you think that you are being bullied or someone else is being bullied

Tell a teacher or another adult that you trust

Bullying behaviour is when someone keeps being mean or hurtful to others on purpose over and over again.



If a student tells a staff member that they think they are being bullied, we will:

- talk with the student
- ask the student what they want to happen
- work out a plan together
- talk to their parents
- talk to the other student(s) involved
- talk with the other student's parents

BCS has a Bí Cineálta policy to try to stop bullying behaviour. We look at this policy every year to see what is working well or what could work better. We will ask you what you think.
